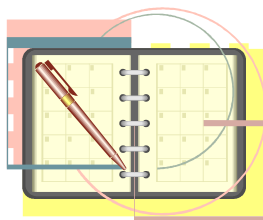
You will want to stand out from the other participants and make a positive impression. Getting the most out of this event will take advance preparation on your part.
